OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Bhubaneswar, dated the 1/8/92

Sub: Revision of the rates of Travelling Allowance.

The question of revising various rates of travelling allowances and also the provisions relating to different entitlements of a Government servant under Orissa Travelling Allowance Rules was under examination of Government. After careful consideration, the Governor has been pleased to decide as follows :-

2. (a) The rates of conveyance allowance wherever admissible under rule -34 of Orissa Travelling Allowance Rules shall be fixed as follows : -

Motor-Cycle/Scooter Allowance ... Rs.175.00 P.M.

Bi-cycle allowance ... Rs. 30.00 P.M.

(b) It has also been decided not to allow Motor-Car Allowance under the aforesaid rule due to the high cost involved in using own motor-car for official purposes within the headquarters of a Government servant. Motor-Car allowance now admissible in any quarter shall be discontinued forth-with.

(c) The rate of mileage allowance for journeys by road other than by own vehicle or public motor services as provided under Rule-53 of Orissa Travelling Allowance Rules shall be fixed as follows : -

(i) First Grade and Second ... Rs.0.50 paise per Grade Government Servant.

(ii) Third Grade and Fourth ... Rs.0.40 paise per Grade Government Servant.

4. The maximum limit on reimbursement of conveyance hiring charges during tour outside the State as admissible under Rule-79(iii) of Orissa Travelling Allowance Rules shall be fixed at Rs.70.00 (seventy) per day.

5. A Government servant, who is entitled to travel by first class accommodation in Train, shall be eligible to travel in N.C. Chair-Car. Such a Government servant shall also be eligible to travel in A.C. Two tier in a particular train in which there is no first class provision at all.

6. The monthly income ceiling of dependant relatives of a Government servant as provided in "Note" below Rule-14 of Orissa Travelling Allowance Rules shall be fixed at Rs.500.00(Five hundred).

7. These changes shall apply to all, inter alia, journeys etc. performed on or after the date of issue of this order. In so far as the rates revised in para 2 of this Office Memorandum are concerned, the said rates shall be effective from 1st August, 1992.

8. Necessary amendments to the Apisym will be made in due course.
