

All Departments of Government.

Sub: Grant of special casual leave to the
Office bearers of the recognised Association
of State Government employees.

The undersigned is directed to say that the question of grant of special casual leave to the office-bearers of the recognised Service Associations for participating in Government the activities of Association was under consideration of Governor for some time past. After careful consideration Governor has been pleased to decide that special casual leave up to a maximum period of 10 days in a calendar year may be allowed in favour of the office-bearers of the recognised Service Associations for participating in the activities of the Associations including attending meetings of Executive Committee and General Body. This will be subject to the exigencies of the public service.

2. The authority competent to sanction casual leave will have powers to grant the special casual leave in respect of the office-bearers of the recognised Service Associations working under his administrative control. The fact as to whether a Government servant is holding an office of the recognised Association or not and whether an Association actually represents the members of any particular recognised Association or not, is to be certified by Government in Home Department and the decision of Home Department will be final.
